Professional Certificate in Contemporary Leadership Course Fees & Structure

Course Fees

- Course fees for the Professional Certificate in Contemporary Leadership as follows (**subject to change**):

MYR 11,113.00* per participant

- Applicants are required to pay a processing & commitment fee as follows (**non-refundable**):

MYR 500.00* per application

Residential Fees

1 week session including graduation in the United Kingdom

- In addition to the course fee, participants are required to pay for the Residential Fee as follows (**subject to change**):

MYR 8,512.00* per participant

- The **Residential Fee covers accommodation, meals, ground transport and logistic for the 1 week residential session in the United Kingdom. Flight cost is NOT included.** Please contact the Secretariat for full fees with flight.

Course Structure

- Participants will need to complete 54 lecture hours in order to graduate
- Three main modules, consisting of 13 core courses and 2 elective courses will be delivered in 12 weeks (3 months)

- **10 hours for 1 week - Residential in Markfield, United Kingdom**

- Residential and physical classes will be held for **seven days** at **Markfield Institute of Higher Education in Markfield, United Kingdom**.

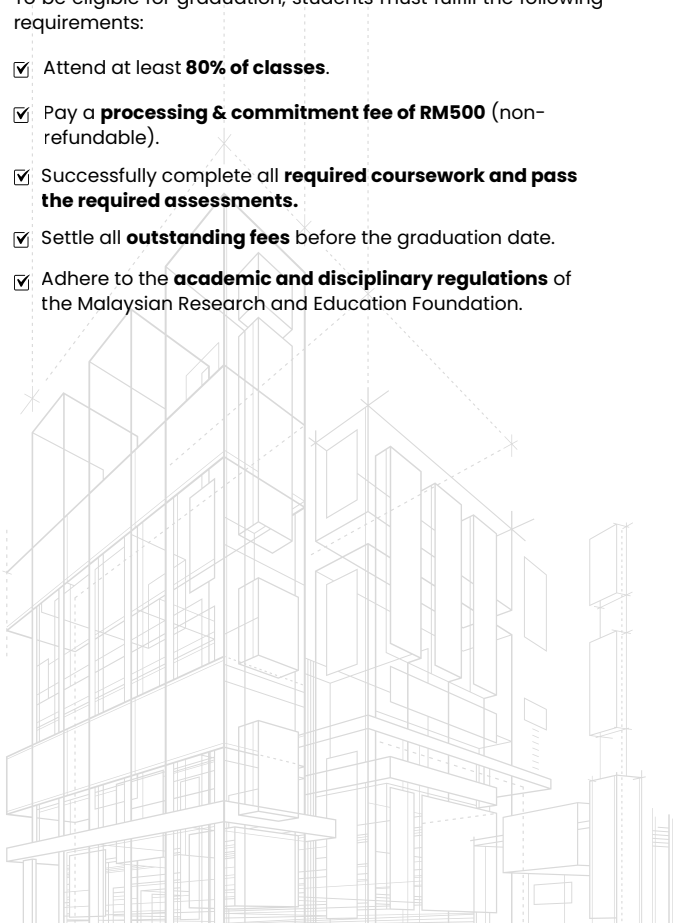
Graduation Terms

Admission Requirements

- 01** Possess a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent
- 02** Possess a minimum of 3 years professional working experience in any field
- 03** Possess prior or current active involvement in any government department, business, industry, Civil Society Organization (CSO), political party or community leadership
- 04** Passed background and basic entry screening conducted by MyREF
- 05** Complete all related application forms with all required documentations being uploaded in the online system

Cancellation Policy

- For **HRD-Corp Grant Participants**, a **penalty of full course fee (RM11,113.00)** apply upon cancellation or no-show after HRD Corp Grant is approved and seat is confirmed.
- For **self-paid participants or NON-HRD Corp Registered Company** that has paid the course fee and secure the seat, the following rules apply:
 - ☑ ≥ 60 days before programme date - **95% refund of course fee**
 - ☑ 30-59 days before programme date - **60% refund of course fee**
 - ☑ 15-29 days before programme date - **30% refund of course fee**
 - ☑ <14 days before programme date or no-show - **NO REFUND**
- This policy does not apply in the event of programme cancellation or postponement by the organiser, or under circumstances deemed to be force majeure.

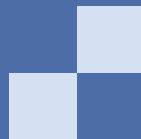
Replacement Policy
